

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Boston Redevelopment Authority ("BRA"), pursuant to Article 80, Section 80A-2 of the Boston Zoning Code ("Code"), hereby gives notice that an Institutional Master Plan ("IMP") Amendment and a Supplemental Materials document were filed with the BRA on November 17, 2009 by Children's Hospital Boston ("Children's") that amends the IMP to include the Main Building Expansion (the "Proposed Project") to be located on Binney Street at the Children's campus in Boston and amends the Children's IMP Area to include the property at 333 Longwood Avenue recently purchased by the Hospital and to include an area on Binney Street. The IMP Amendment and Supplemental Materials document are in response to the Scoping Determination issued by the BRA.

The Proposed Project will expand Children's Main Building with approximately 80,000 SF of new space located on the site of the existing 7,000 SF 57 Binney Street Building. The Project will add approximately 73,000 SF of net new space to the Core Campus. The proposed Main Building Expansion will include 10 stories: four floors devoted to single inpatient beds (a net increase of up to 36 beds), a Radiology floor, Surgical Services, observation beds associated with the existing Main Building Emergency Department, a floor for an MRI and Pharmacy, and mechanical space.

Consistent with this IMP Amendment, Boston Zoning Map 1 will be further amended to eliminate the PDA Overlay District for PDA No. 16, and to increase the area of the Children's Hospital Institutional Master Plan Area to include PDA No. 16 (333 Longwood Avenue) and the area of the Binney Street sidewalk beneath the cantilever of the Proposed Project. Children's seeks the issuance of an Adequacy Determination by the Director of the BRA for the approval of the IMP Amendment.
