Internet Point of Care CME provides 1.0 Category 1 credits for using peer-reviewed sources to research a clinical question relevant to your practice. This self-directed activity cannot be used for similar online research required for teaching or research purposes. The objectives of this activity are to:

- Ask a clinical question
- List the resource(s) consulted
- Determine if the information researched applied to your practice or patient care

To receive CME credits, you will need to complete the form and evaluation.

Evidenced-based practice relies on forming the clinical question which is often in the PICO format (patient population/intervention/comparison/outcome). There is a list of peer-reviewed resources on the submission form which include: Cochrane Library, PubMed, UpToDate and Clinical Practice Guidelines either developed by CHB (Children's Hospital Boston Clinical Practice Guidelines are available in the eLibrary: <http://chbelibrary.tch.harvard.edu/C19/cpg/default.aspx>) or the National Guideline Clearinghouse.
