What is a Certified Hand Therapist?

A Certified Hand Therapist (CHT) is an occupational therapist (OT) or physical therapist (PT) who specializes in treating the arm and hand. All CHTs have at least three years of experience and have passed an exam on treating problems in the arm and hand. While there are over 200,000 PTs in the United States, there are only about 6,000 CHTs, so they can be harder to find!


How to Find a Hand Therapist Near You

1.) Visit the Hand Therapy Certification Commission


