BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: James Roswell Gallagher was a specialist in teen-age health who shaped the field of Adolescent Medicine into a recognized discipline. He began his work at Children's Hospital Boston in 1951 and organized the country's first comprehensive medical section caring for adolescents aged 12-21 years. He retired in 1967 as clinical professor of pediatrics and Chief of the Adolescent Unit. He became Clinical Professor of Pediatrics at Yale University School of Medicine until he retired in 1972.
