Birgit Lorenz, MD, PhD
Justus-Liebig-University Giessen

Dr. Lorenz is the Director and Chair of Ophthalmology at the Justus-Liebig University of Giessen in Germany and serves as a Professor of Neuro-Ophthalmology and Ophthalmic Genetics. Her research focuses on a number of conditions including retinopathy of prematurity, retinal degeneration, gene therapy for hereditary disorders, and pathophysiology of strabismus disorders. Dr. Lorenz was founding president of the European Paediatric Ophthalmological Society and is a Fellow of the European Board of Ophthalmology. She currently serves as a scientific advisory board member of Pro Retina Deutschland and of the Allianz Chronischer Seltener Erkrankungen. She is editor of 3 books and has published more than 180 peer-reviewed papers.
