

COVID-19 Vaccine Updates

We as a practice strongly encourage our patients to be vaccinated as soon as they are eligible. It is not yet known whether Pediatrics at Newton Wellesley will receive vaccines. We will notify you immediately once we have more information.

- Patients 12+ years old are eligible for the Pfizer vaccine. All patients 18+ are eligible for the Moderna and J&J vaccines.
- If you have received the vaccine and have not yet contacted our office, please email pnw466@gmail.com with the date(s) of your vaccine and a photo of your vaccination card

- Please note that children under 18 years of age need written consent to receive the vaccine if they are not accompanied by a parent. - Covid-19 vaccines and other vaccinations may now be administered without regard to timing to each other. This includes simultaneous administration on the same day as well as within 14 days of other vaccine series.
