## Have you heard about the clinical research support available in Waltham?

As a reminder, the following services are available to support you and your study teams as you restart clinical research operations:

- Phlebotomy, currently by appointment only. Please call 617-355-5618 to schedule.
- Spinning and aliquoting of blood samples.
- Courier service to Boston for research biospecimens. [Download the courier schedule here.](#)
- -80 freezer space for short term sample storage (up to two weeks).
- Senior clinical research project manager, Dan Elman, is now based at Waltham to assist investigators and study team members with clinical research operations guidance, navigating clinical research resources, and education resources. He can also help you access resources not physically available at Waltham, including study monitoring.
- Investigators can purchase hours of Waltham-based research coordinator or project management support to assist with screening, recruitment, study visits, sample collection, and more.
