


Well Child Care and Immunizations

Preventive health care, including immunizations, is very important in keeping your child healthy. We follow all preventive health care recommendations of the American Academy of Pediatrics as described in the table below.

Our Well Visit Schedule

Newborn	This is the first visit to our office after the child is born, typically at 3-5 days	15 months	Growth and development, immunizations
2 weeks	Growth and development, newborn screen	18 months	Growth and development, immunizations
2 months	Growth and development, immunizations	24 months	Growth and development, lead screening, hemoglobin screening
4 months	Growth and development, immunizations	30 months	Growth and development
6 months	Growth and development, immunizations	3 years	Growth and development, vision screening, lead screening, hemoglobin screening
9 months	Growth and development, lead screening, hemoglobin screening, catch up on any missed immunizations	4 years	Growth and development, vision and hearing screening, lead screening, hemoglobin screening, immunizations
12 months	Growth and development, immunizations	5+ years	Yearly well visits with immunizations at 11 and 16 years with periodic hearing and vision screening
